# Executive Summary

- Intel® Remote Keyboard is a new mobile app from Intel that allows users to use a mobile device to provide input to their Intel® Compute Stick or Intel® NUC.
- Intel Remote Keyboard mobile app was released on the Google Play Store on Friday June 19.
- The app has also been submitted to the Apple Store and is expected to complete the review process and be posted the week of June 30.
- The purpose of the app is to allow users of the Intel NUC and Intel Compute Stick products to control those computers using their Android or iOS based devices.
- The host app (the software that is needed on the computer to be controlled) is available from the Intel® Download Center and was designed for Windows 8.1

# Intel® Remote Keyboard Setup

- Download the Intel® Remote Keyboard mobile app from the Google Play Store or Apple Store on your mobile device.
- Download and install the Intel Remote Keyboard host app from the [Intel® Download Center](#) on your Intel Compute Stick or Intel NUC
- Open the app on your mobile device
- Select the computer from the device list and scan the QR code on your computer's screen (first use only)

That's it! Now you can provide input to your computer from your mobile device.
